Connect to IU Wi-Fi via your Eduroam Credentials from Other Institutions

Guests visiting IU campuses have access to high-speed wireless internet on campus through eduroam, the new default wireless network for everyone.

To connect your device to the free wireless internet service using Eduroam Credentials:

- 1. In your device settings, make sure wireless networking (or Wi-Fi) is turned on.
- 2. In the list of available networks, select Eduroam.
- 3. Use your home campus email address and passphrase as login credentials.

Guest Wi-Fi for IU visitors

Guests visiting IU campuses can access Wi-Fi by using the IU Guest network.

To connect your device to the free wireless internet service for IU campus visitors:

- 4. In your device settings, make sure wireless networking (or Wi-Fi) is turned on.
- 5. In the list of available networks, select IU Guest.
- 6. If your browser doesn't open to the IU Guest page automatically, launch your browser.
- 7. On the "IU Guest WiFi" screen, enter your email address, check the box to accept the terms of use, and then select connect.
